## SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA

### ***SCALES***

All scales to be memorized, tongued and slurred.

Chromatic – in a triplet pattern, 3 octaves starting on low E

Major Scales: C – 2 octaves F – 3 octaves, Bb – 2, G – 2 octaves, D – 2 octaves

Melodic minor scales ascending and descending: a – 2 octaves, d – 2 octave, g – 2 octaves, e – 3 octaves, b – 2 octaves

### ***REPERTOIRE***

Two contrasting movements or sections of a solo piece.

Suggested repertoire includes but is not limited to:

Cavallini, E. – Adagio and Tarantella

Osborne, W. – Rhapsody for Clarinet

Saint-Saens, C. – Sonate pour Clarinet (mvt. 1)

Weber, C. von – Concerto No. 1 in f minor (mvt. 1)

### ***SCALES***
